- We have been informed that the expansion will involve:
 - o Up to thirty two B-double trucks passing our residence per hour;

 - o Significant impacts on residences including:
 - Noise 24hrs a day
 - Dust
 - Traffic intensity/safety in accessing property
 - Devaluation of properties
