Further to your email dated 2 August 2019 seeking clarification on correspondence issued by the Heritage Council of NSW for SSD 10251 Notice of Exhibition for 42 Honeysuckle Drive, Newcastle, dated 26 July 2019.

The referral information has been reconsidered given the Department's clarification that the works are an internal building modification to levels 5 and above, rather than works which may disturb archaeological 'relics' within the meaning of the *Heritage Act 1977*. Given this clarification, please disregard the comment issued in the letter dated 26 July 2019 and be advised the Heritage Council of NSW raises no issues with the currently referred modification.

As raised with officers of Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, the information referred and available for public comment included the original documents for parts of the site not relevant to this modification.
