Reference is made to your correspondence received on 12 December 2016 requesting advice recommended consent conditions from the Heritage Council of NSW (the Heritage Council) for the above proposal.

The proposed State Significant Development site, 5-15 Trivett Street and 130-174 Cowpasture Road, Wetherill Park, Fairfield, is in the vicinity of State Heritage Register item, *Upper Canal System* (*Pheasants Nest Weir to Prospect Reservoir*) – SHR no. 1373.

Further to the Division's advice in its letter dated 7 June 2016, it is recommended that the following conditions be part of the approval:

- The recommendations of the Archaeological Report and Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment, both by Biosys, dated 10 October 2016 should be implemented, with procedures for the discovery of unanticipated Aboriginal objects, historical relics or Aboriginal ancestral remains and continued consultation with registered Aboriginal stakeholders.
- Recommendation 2 of the Heritage Impact Statement prepared by Biosys dated 9 November 2016 should be implemented, with regard to minimum building setbacks from the western edge (Upper Canal System) boundary, landscaping to include shrubs and trees capable of reaching and thus buffering proposed building heights and building design to avoid high, blank walls facing the Canal, to avoid adverse impacts on the significance of the Upper Canal System (Lot 1 DP 596354).
