Description of proposal

The above State significant development (SSD) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was exhibited from Friday 28 June 2019 until Thursday 25 July 2019 and between Monday 9 December 2019 and Friday 31 January 2020. The Applicant has submitted a Response to Submissions (RtS) that responds to the comments made in submissions lodged by government agencies and the public. The RtS also includes amendments to the proposed development.

Amendments to the proposal include:

Concept Proposal

• expand the site boundary to include No. 4 Mount Pleasant Avenue;

- amend the staging of infrastructure works to align with proposed student population increase;
- · reduce and amend of the building envelope sizes and heights;
- amend 'Building envelope 8' to comprise an all-weather field at Osborn Road level with underground carpark;
- delete of 'Building envelopes 3, 9, 10' and the Bush Chapel; and
- increase car parking to 433 spaces.

Stage 1 Works

- reduce the height of the student boarding accommodation and increase setback from Mount Pleasant Avenue;
- amend the scale, architectural and landscape design in relation to the student boarding accommodation;
- introduce a link road between Osborn Road and Mount Pleasant Avenue;
- · revise pick-up and drop-off arrangements and undercover pedestrian shelter;
- increase car parking at the Osborn Road car park to support the Stage 1 works; and
- remove two existing sports courts and provide underground carpark with two new sports court on the roof.
