**Subject: Woodlawn Bioreactor Modification – Addition of SRF Processing Facility**

Goulburn Mulwaree Council wishes to make the following comments in relation to this state significant modification:

**General Comments**

- Council supports the concept because it diverts additional residual waste from the bioreactor, and therefore extends its potential lifespan, as well as the potential to provide additional economic benefits to the Tarago district and broader Goulburn Mulwaree LGA via the creation of additional jobs.

**Specific Comments**

- It is Council's view that contributions under the Goulburn Mulwaree Section 94 Development Contributions Plan 2009 will apply to the additional heavy vehicle haulage movements proposed for the Collector Rd and Bungendore Rd transportation route as specified in this modification (i.e. the movement of containers from the site to the Crisps Creek Inter-Modal Facility).
- Council acknowledges the history of odour complaints emanating from the existing waste management operations. In this regard it is also acknowledged that works are currently being undertaken separate to this modification to improve Woodlawn's overall odour management, particularly in relation to leachate. In this regard it is satisfied that the odour management system for the proposed SRF Processing Facility will be controlled provided that the system is maintained and operated at all times.
