Hello Bruce,

Further to our phone conversation yesterday, I confirm that Queanbeyan Palerang Regional Council will not be providing a submission in relation to this latest notification in regard to the proposed Woodlawn Mechanical Biological Treatment Facility.

It is councils understanding that the proposed modification involves no changes to maximum waste volumes handled upon the site, rather the operator of the site is seeking to extract certain waste material for treatment (drying and shredding) onsite and wholesale resale. This process will result in 110 additional vehicle movements per fortnight from the site to the Crisps Creek intermodal site, though all vehicle movements are included within existing approved limits for the site. Regardless, there will be no additional vehicle movements within the Queanbeyan-Palerang LGA as a result of the proposed modification.
