Subject: Woodlawn Mechanical Biological Treatment Facility - Modification 2 (MP 06_0239 MOD2) and Crisps Creek Intermodal Facility (MP 10_0012 MOD 3)

Thank you for the email received 24 July 2018 requesting WaterNSW's comments on Woodlawn Mechanical Biological Treatment Facility - Modification 2 (MP 06_0239 MOD2) and Crisps Creek Intermodal Facility (MP 10_0012 MOD 3).

WaterNSW has reviewed the Statement of Environmental Effects prepared by SG Haddad Advisory and CW Strategic Planning Services (version 5, dated 6 July 2018) and has the following comments.

WaterNSW requests information on the capacity of the sewage treatment plant (STP) and whether the STP has adequate capacity for the increase in personnel at the site due to the establishment of the Solid Recovered Fuel facility.

Notwithstanding, WaterNSW considers that the carrying out of the proposed modification is unlikely to change impacts on water quality than previously assessed, provided that the existing Soil and Water Management Plan, associated monitoring programs and Construction Management Plan for the site are updated accordingly, and remains in place.

Considering the above, WaterNSW requests the following:

- The Soil and Water Management Plan as required by Schedule 2, Condition 17 of MP 10_0012 and associated monitoring programs be amended to reflect the proposed site layout changes and that any revisions be referred to WaterNSW for comment.
- 2. The requirements outlined as Statement of Commitments in Section 5 of the Statement of Environmental Effects be referred to in an amended approval to ensure a regulatory basis for the proposed controls to be maintained.

It is requested that WaterNSW remain as a stakeholder for the proposal and any updates to relevant plans. WaterNSW would like to be consulted during revisions to any relevant plans, including the operational and construction environmental plans.
