Thank you for your letter 9 June 2017 requesting Transport for NSW (TfNSW) review and comment on the exhibition of the subject project.

TfNSW has reviewed the documents supporting the proposal and has the following comments.

TfNSW advise that Princes Motorway Mount Ousley Interchange Project is currently in the concept design process and no timeframe for construction has been established. TfNSW encourages the use of active transport and is supportive of the programs and infrastructure provided by the University of Wollongong. The applicant should continue to develop travel access guides to assist with increasing the mode share of walking and cycling for staff, students and visitors.

Prior to the commencement of any work on site, the applicant should provide a Construction Pedestrian and Traffic Management Plan (CPTMP) highlighting any potential impacts to general traffic, cyclists, pedestrians and bus services within the vicinity of the site from construction vehicles during the proposed works.
