Dear Mr Hay

I refer to the Department of Planning and Environment's letter dated 22 July 2019 requesting the NSW Environment Protection Authority's (EPA) comments on the exhibition of Alterations and Additions to Meriden School Margaret Street and Redmyre Road, Strathfield (SSD-9692) (the proposal).

The proposal involves:

- Demolition of an existing buildings and construction of a new multi-storey buildings on the Junior School, Senior and Lingwood Campuses;
- Increased capacity for an additional 50 students across all three campuses; and
- Associated works, including tree removal and landscaping.

In its letter dated 1 November 2018 (ref DOC18/827160-01) the EPA stated that it has no further interest in the proposal and no further consultation is required.

Based on the information provided, the proposal does not require an Environment Protection Licence under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*. The proposal is not being undertaken by or on behalf of a NSW public authority, and the EPA is not the appropriate regulatory authority for the proposal. In view of these factors, the EPA has no further interest in the proposal and no further consultation is required.
