To whom it may concern:

I wish to place on notice formal objection to AGL Gas Newcastle Gas Storage Facility at Tomago with pipeline to Hexham, on behalf of Australian Water Campaigners, a group dedicated to protecting Australia's water resources from contamination. In this case our concern is based on the potentially damaging impact of the Coal Seam Gas industry, and also the likely impact on the lower Hunter River and estuary, an area noted for its Ramsar listed Wetlands.
