With respect to the proposed modification of the abovementioned development, consisting of a Gas Take off Facility, Custody Transfer Facility, Tie in Point and Low Pressure Pipeline, Council has reviewed the supplied documentation and wishes to provide the following comments for your consideration.

Gas Take off Facility and Custody Transfer Facility

It is noted that the works for these modifications are proposed to occur within the existing approved and disturbed footprint of the development. Given that these modifications are unlikely to result in any additional impacts, Council does not have any specific requirements or additional conditions to recommend.

Tie in Point

Council has no specific concerns or requirements with respect to this component of the development.

Low Pressure Pipeline

Council recognise that the proposal has been sited to minimise disturbance of vegetation. So long as the proposal incorporates the recommendations and conclusions or Sections 4 and 5 of the "Newcastle Gas Storage Facility Project - Modification 2 Ecology Assessment" prepared by EMM, 11 September 2013. Given the trenching proposed, thought should be given with respect to whether the development will intercept an aquifer requiring separate approvals from the Office of Water. Consideration should also be given to the impacts of Acid Sulfate Soils.
