Comment by NSW Office of Water

The NSW Office of Water advises:

- (i) There are no objections to the proposal.
- (ii) The existing conditions of approval for the facility and the mitigation measures outlined in the Environmental Assessment are considered adequate to address the potential impacts of the proposal.
- (iii) The proponent is required to hold an access licence with sufficient allocation in the Tomago Groundwater Source (under the *Water Sharing Plan for the Tomago Tomaree Stockton Water Sources*) to account for expected dewatering volumes prior to commencement of any dewatering activities. The excavation to be dewatered would need to be registered as a nominated work on the applicable access licence(s). An application under s71W of the *Water Management Act 2000* is required to nominate works on an access licence. Dealings are assessed against the provisions of the water sharing plan and the Access Licence Dealings Principles Order 2004 (available at http://www.legislation.nsw.gov.au/maintop/view/inforce/subordleg+433+2004+cd+0+N)).
