**Dendrobium Mine Extension Project (SSD 8194) (Areas 5 and 6).**

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comment in relation the Dendrobium Mine Extension Project (Dendrobium Mine Extension Project (SSD 8194)).

It is understood the Project involves;

- The expansion of Dendrobium Coal Mine into Areas 5 and 6.
- Extraction of run-of-mine (ROM) coal from the new mining areas by longwall mining methods, at a rate of 5.2 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa) for 18 years; and
- First workings and total extraction by longwall techniques within the Wongawilli and Bulli Coal Seams within the areas defined in Appendix A Subsidence Assessment.

Subsidence Advisory notes Appendix A of the Environmental Impact Statement includes a built environment impact assessment. As infrastructure including gas pipelines and high voltage powerlines is predicted to be influenced by mine subsidence, Subsidence Advisory requests consultation during the development of these management plans.
