## Re: Submission to object the proposal of CVC 3 and Mannering Colliery Modification 5

I live in Macquarie Shores Home Village and my house is located about 800 m away from Mannering Colliery Coal Breaker and about 1 km away from Vales Power Station.

The vibrating, buzzing, thumbing, clanging, and machinery noises emitting from Mannering Colliery and Vales Power Point Station have been interfering with my sleep and affecting my health profoundly. My neighbours who are retirees in the village are experiencing the same problem.

The noises emitting from Mannering Colliery and Vales Power Station is a current on-going complaint issue and your Compliance Department presently is investigating the problem. I am aware that your Compliance Department did detect elevated noises emitting from Mannering Colliery and Vales Power Station between mid night and 7 am from their own investigation and are requesting Delta to re-confirm the sources and level of noise.

To increase the transport of run-of-mine coal from Chain Valley Colliery to Mannering Colliery to 2.1 million tonnes, breaking the coal at Mannering which is located 800 m away from my house and transporting it using overland conveyor to Vales Point Power Station would exacerbate the level and duration of the current noise problem immensely. Also I am concerned about the increase in coal dust deposit along the house which I and residents in the village are currently experiencing coal dust pollution from the power station.
