- The impact on the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Area known as the Drips
- The CMA has Investment in Weed Control and Erosion control of The Drips area. The impact this development and commitment of the mine to improve and maintain thsi area.
- There appears to be no acknowledgement or adherence of the water sharing plan.
- Water Study differs from the nearby and adjacent mines in critical areas.
