- Mine disturbance footprint of 1546 ha of native vegetation including 4.1 kms of Murragamba creek, 4.1 kms of eastern creek
- Clearing of over 900 has of native forest (123ha EEC Box Woodland).
- Biodiversity offsets are located outside the Hunter Valley catchment, do not represent 'like for like' nor replace the net loss to the bio-region
