Supplementary Submission- Wallerawang Ash Repository Mod 1, Lot 16 DP 555844, Lot 17 DP 855844 and Lot 5 DP 829137, Wallerawang Power Station

Further to Council's staff submission of 6 April 2018 in relation to the Wallerawang Ash Repository Mod 1, Council further considered the matter at its Ordinary meeting of 23 April 2018 and at its ordinary meeting held 26 March 2018. It was resolved to reaffirm its submission of opposition to the proposal.

In this regard, so there can be no doubt of the Council's position on the matter, it would be helpful to state the Council's resolution of 26 March 2018 below:

THAT the GM or Acting GM (as appropriate) be delegated authority to forward a submission to Department of Planning and Environment to emphasise the necessity that soil be free of contamination; that 300 truck movements per day is excessive; and if approved, fill must be transported by rail. Hawksbury and Blue Mountains Councils also be advised of the proposal.

Council has contacted Hawkesbury and Blue Mountains Council's but would appreciate if the Council's resolution above *to emphasise the necessity that soil be free of contamination; that 300 truck movements per day is excessive; and if approved, fill must be transported by rail* be specifically considered."
