Hi Leanne,

Apologies for the delayed response; we've been exceptionally understaffed.

If it is not too late, I have been able to ascertain some points for input from our Air Navigation section:

- There are currently three instrument approach procedures to Westmead Hospital (YWST), NDB 127, RNAV-Z (GNSS) 052 and RNAV-Z (GNSS) 127.
- Airservices is the responsible procedure design organisation for these approaches.
 - The specific details of construction including building height, size, location and crane heights will need to be assessed to determine if there will be any impact to the existing procedures during and after construction.
 - The existing procedures will also need to be reviewed to determine their suitability with respect to the proposed helipad location.
- Changes to aeronautical information, such as the location of helipads, must be notified to Airservices AIS by the person responsible for the data/information.
