

I strongly object, to MULTIQUIPS 'NEW' proposal to act as a local quarry and use unimproved local roads. The condition in place, agreed, to the road upgrades, prior to use for deliveries via quarry trucks and Multiquip, now seek a change, to use local roads, such as 'JERRARA ROAD, BUNGONIA' prior to any road upgrades. The roads, are not fit for these trucks. They have not been upgraded as promised, as per the submitted agreement, 'to use the road'. The roads have broken edges and are narrow generally for two lanes as they currently are, for normal car (size) use, let alone a truck to fit at one side, and a normal car almost run off the road. As a user of this road, we are forced to drive off the road, on the one side for trucks passing and on the gravel, to 'stop' and then proceed when the ^{truck} has passed, for safety and concern of and avoidance of damage and to avoid any other unsafe occurrences.

I do not agree at all, to this road being used any further, without the original agreement being addressed 'if' and only the roads were to be upgraded.

For the safety of the drivers in use, I am not agreeing and am highly opposed to, any changes, MR MIKOSIC and Multiquip or any other truck company 'SEEK' in using this road - JERRARA ROAD OR any other local roads at all.
