It is sad that an organisation such as Multiquip Quarries has tried to dupe the local community in thinking it has best interests at heart, yet we now hear of a proposal for Multiquip to use the local roads prior to the completion of the relevant route upgrade we first heard about.

As a local I have heard nothing direct from Multiquip and have confirmed with other locals who also share the concern of not being consulted. As a resident of Jerrara Road, I am worried the use of the road as a transport route will have a negative effect on all of us.
