**AMENDED EIS FOR ENERGY FROM WASTE FACILITY
HONEYCOMB DRIVE EASTERN CREEK**

Reference is made to DP&E's correspondence dated 12 December 2016 with regard to the abovementioned Development Application, which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services (Roads and Maritime) for comment.

Roads and Maritime has reviewed the submitted documentation and the following issues are to be addressed prior to the determination of the application.

1. The applicant is requested to provide an electronic copy of the SIDRA 6 modelling of the surrounding intersections, in particular the Wallgrove Road and Wonderland Drive intersection, to allow further assessment of the traffic impacts of the proposal.
2. Further clarification is requested from the applicant regarding the proposed future access to Archbold Road. The applicant is requested to align the proposal with the revised RMS intersection location so that the development is consistent with the RMS concept design for Archbold Road (see attached plans for further information).
3. Further clarification is requested from the applicant regarding the proposed access road from Honeycomb Drive. Road design details should be provided for assessments.

The applicant is advised that the above information is required to allow Roads and Maritime to complete the assessment of this Application. Roads and Maritime may also request further information once the assessment is carried out.
