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
**Significant Development Modification: Fort Street Public School**

To whom it concerns:

In principle, I support the redevelopment of Fort St School. However, the increase in height of Building J is out of context with the tree-line and its height and size is unwarranted.

In addition, the proposed facade of Building J (as depicted in the disingenuous photo from the car park - i.e. it ignores the view of this new facade from the hundreds of apartments all around it - and assumes instead that people will be sitting in their cars looking at it!) is completely out of context with the surrounding sandstone and old brick finishes. This general area of Sydney is one of the most historical - if the most historical - in the city and any development should surely take that into account.
