Comment by NSW Office of Water

The NSW Office of Water advises that it can support the proposed modification based on the following comment and recommended condition of consent:

(i) The proposed access road indicates the requirement to construct a temporary crossing of an existing watercourse and two crossings of the proposed clean water diversion channel. It is recommended watercourse crossings be consistent with the Office of Water *Guidelines for Controlled Activities* (July 2012), and be updated accordingly within the relevant construction and operational management plans.

(ii) Recommended condition

1. The Soil and Water Management Plan is to be amended in consultation with the NSW Office of Water. Watercourse crossings are to be consistent with the *Controlled Activities on Waterfront Land Guidelines for Riparian Corridors on Waterfront Land* (NSW Office of Water, July 2012).
