Comment by Fisheries NSW

Fisheries NSW has assessed the modification proposal in accordance with the requirements of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (namely the aquatic habitat protection and threatened species conservation provisions in Part 7 and 7A of that Act, respectively) and the associated *Policy and Guidelines for Fish Habitat Conservation and Management (2013)* and advise:

- (i) No objection to the proposed modifications
- (ii) However it is recommended that erosion and sedimentation control measures are employed to mitigate turbidity related impacts on the aquatic environment. This should include the use of sediment curtains during in water works.

Comment by Crown Lands

Crown Lands advise that they have met with Mr Bob Grounds, the lessor at Cronulla Marina and discussed a number of issues related to the tenure over the site, and in particular the area Below Mean High Water Mark, and the adjacent reserve.

It is advised that Crown Lands cannot provide Land Owners Consent to the current application until a number of issues are resolved around a potential Land Claim, Native Title and tenure generally over the site. Crown Lands will conduct further investigation and provide advice in due course.
