In response to the Environmental Assessment Exhibition above, Endeavour Energy notes that the number of apartments for the total project remains at 800.

Full development of the former Channel 7 site will also requires a number of new substation sites to be installed at suitable locations on site so that low voltage supplies can be made available to the various apartment blocks.

Endeavour Energy has responded to the applicants request for electricity supply under the three stages totalling 800 apartments. It appears that this environmental assessment public exhibition does not alter the proposed method of high voltage supply to those new substations
