RE: SSD-10831778 – Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 / Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre (SCH1/CCCC) - Response to Submissions (RTS)

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in support of a State Significant Development Application (SSDA) for the construction and operation of the SCH1/CCCC at Randwick was publicly exhibited for a period of 28 days, from 19 May 2021 to 15 June 2021 inclusive (SSD-10831778).

In total, 9 submissions were received from public authorities and 3 submissions were received from members of the public in response to the public exhibition of the EIS.
