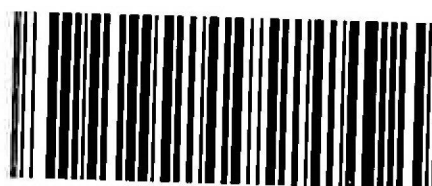

Agency Comment – Modification of Development Consent: Glen Innes Wind Farm MP07_0036 MOD 3

I refer to your letter dated 3 July 2014 seeking comments from the NSW Rural Fire Service regarding the above mentioned development.

The NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) understands the modification proposal consists of the following request:

- *Amend condition 1.5 of the consent to permit the consent to operate for a period of five (5) years from the date the consent was granted.*

The RFS notes that no documentation was referred that indicated which conditions of the development consent issued 2 September 2010 (and as amended by MOD1 dated 16 August 2013) have been applied to be modified.

However, the RFS has no objection to the modification proposal proceeding, providing the bush fire conditions, numbered 2.36, 2.37 and 2.38, contained in the Notice of Development Consent dated 2 September 2010 and as modified 16 August 2013, remaining unchanged.
