RE: Submission- Proposed Dolwende Quarry Project- SSD 6519

On the 10th December 2015 Mangoola Coal received a letter from Adam Bishop (Senior Environmental Consultant KMH Environmental) advising that the Proposed Dolwende Quarry Project (SSD 6519) was on public exhibition until 1st February 2016.

Mangoola Coal has been operational since 2010 in accordance with Project Approval 06_0014. Over this time Mangoola Coal has refined its environmental management and impact mitigation measures to limit the impacts on near neighbours and the surrounding community.

Mangoola Coal requests that consistent environment and community management and performance measures are applied to the proposed quarry, commensurate with the risk of impacts occurring.

Mangoola Coal has reviewed the information contained in the various Environmental technical studies.

Mangoola Coal does not object to the proposed State Significant Development, however, if the proposed quarry is approved, Mangoola Coal requests that consideration be given to applying appropriate conditions to address the following:

1. Mangoola Coal owns an approved Biodiversity Offset on land adjacent to the proposed development. The biodiversity values on this offset land must be protected from the indirect impacts of the proposed quarry activities.
2. The outcomes of the air quality, noise and blasting studies demonstrate that possible cumulative impacts may exist. Measures should be taken to:
 - a. Monitor local air quality and noise to determine the quarry contribution;
 - b. Consult with Mangoola Coal when blasting is going to occur to ensure that cumulative impacts are managed and blasts do not occur simultaneously.
