The reason being Ward Park is a bit dangerous due to the presence of residents with mental health and other issues.

Furthermore, a lot of eateries are situated along Crown Street, so passengers would have quite a long walk to get to these eateries.

Perhaps a survey could be done to ascertain if there would be need for getting off at Crown Street?

The lighting on lower Devonshire Street, from Ward Park to Crown Street, is very poor which makes me fear for my safety.

I also believe the distance from the stop at Central to Ward Park is very short, compared to the distance from Ward Park to the Moore Park stop. A more equal distance between stops would be preferred.

Being a blind person I am mostly concerned about safety. Thank you.
