## PA07\_0018 MOD 4: Rasp Mine Extension Project; 130 Eyre Street, Broken Hill

Thank you for your email of 13 April 2017 referring the Modification Application and Environmental Assessment for the proposed Rasp Mine Extension Project to Roads and Maritime Services for comment.

The proposal involves modifications to Blackwood Pit tailings storage facility to increase its storage capacity and development of an on-site concrete batching plant at Rasp Mine. The proposal does not involve changes to the approved extraction rates, transportation of materials off-site or the mine life.

The applicant has provided an environmental assessment which indicates that the impact on the local road network, namely Holten Drive and Wentworth Road (HW22), is reduced by approximately 50% due to the installation of a concrete batch plant on-site. Roads and Maritime has reviewed this analysis and is satisfied with its findings.

Roads and Maritime will not object to the proposed modification and makes no submission.
