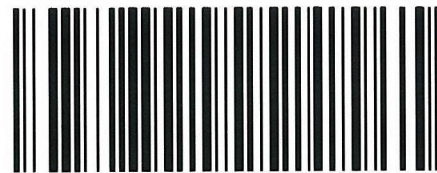

I do not support this application.

This change in higher frequency noise levels to 65-70 decibels and 55-60 decibels will further disturb the local amenity.

The 2014 Splendour concert was highly disturbing, the noise, kept us awake for 3 nights and seemed like the festival was in our yard.

While they (Porklands) are proposing to lower the low frequency 70-75 decibels

the 70 decibels out September in 2015
caused the disturbance.

It is apparant that Parklands cannot
manage the sound limits they agreed to
in the 5 year trial.
That is their problem!

It is not appropriate to change the
noise limits in the middle of the trial
period. Also considering that there were
a significant number of complaints
during September 2014.

This site (Parklands) is not appropriate
so close to a quiet residential area
and surrounded by the Billinudgel
Nature Reserve.
