Please do not approve the Macquarie River pipeline proposal as it is an ill considered and unsustainable project. There are better options available to secure our water supply and indeed that will also protect our environment and native species such as the endangered trout cod population that will be impacted seriously if this project goes ahead.

The existing Suma park dam does not currently meet safety standards and should be upgraded as a matter of urgency, this could include a lifting of the wall to increase present capacity.

The environmental assessment appears to have several anomalies in it and needs to be seriously looked at. These were pointed out at a public meeting held last night.

I would very much appreciate your rejection of this project as it stands with a view to considering several options some of which are of a regional solution that appear to have considerable merit.
