Thank you for your letter about the development proposal referenced above. We have reviewed the proposal and provide the following comments for your consideration.

Water and Wastewater

- Connection is available to the existing water and wastewater systems in Darling Drive
- Adjustments to the existing systems may be required to suit road-realignment
- Adjustments will be confirmed depending on the location and layout of the site during the Section 73 process.

Stormwater

- As initially discussed with the proponents, Sydney Water is concerned with the ICC Hotel proposed over Sydney Water's 1.8H x 2.4W stormwater culvert
- As per the SICEEP Site Servicing Strategy signed by Sydney Water, the proposed Hotel does not comply or is consistent with Sydney Water's 'Building over and adjacent to stormwater assets' guidelines
- The proponents have not discussed with Sydney Water future adjustment and deviation options away from the proposed hotel
- Options to be considered must be feasible through engineering investigations, modelling, detailed concept design and must be undertaken in liaison with Sydney Water
- Any alignment route identified through this work must be reserved on the title of the land.

The developer must fund any adjustments/amplifications needed in accordance with Sydney Water's funding policy.

The developer should engage a Water Servicing Coordinator to get a Section 73 Certificate and manage the servicing aspects of the development including building over and adjacent to Sydney Water assets.
