

If the Jupiter Wind Farm is built I will have a view of over 40 wind turbines from my home. I find this unacceptable. I live here for the peaceful views which I enjoy. I do have trees growing to buffer the noise from the road, but the area which is not treed will leave me with a full view of 40 massive turbines the height of a 55 storey building.

I will be not much over 2 km from the nearest turbine. Although, as the turbines may not be in the exact position that they are on the map, I could be closer.

When I look at the Telstra Tower near Tarago Village it appears quite high, it is only 20 metres high. I have difficulty imagining 40 wind turbines 173 metres high. It is hard to believe that these industrial structures are allowed to be built amongst rural homes. Most people live out here for the lifestyle, as I do. I am outside most of the day on the quad bike and will really not want to live here if they are built.

Besides the health effects these turbines have on a lot of people the visual effect will be horrific.

I won't want to live here if the turbines are built, I request that my home be bought by the proponent at the time of approval at pre-windfarm valuation.
