PROPOSED JUPITER WIND FARM

I refer to the advice provided by CASA in April 2016 regarding the proposed Jupiter Wind Farm and your subsequent correspondence in May 2016 providing additional information with a request for a review of the CASA position.

As you know, we had to refer this to members of the Flying Inspectorate team in our Sydney office for advice. Your request was examined in detail by the Sydney office.

The review concluded that the original CASA advice provided in April 2016 remains appropriate. Accordingly, wind turbines with a height greater than 150 metres Above Ground Level (AGL) should be obstacle lit. As you are aware, the NASF Guideline D provides advice on lighting requirements.

In response to your recent enquiry about the use of radar activated lighting systems, as discussed at our meeting and explained in our previous letter, NASF Guideline D foreshadowed the alternative of using radar activated lighting systems. We have previously provided you a copy of a document from the United States Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regarding its assessment of one such system which includes a copy of the relevant pages of the FAA Advisory Circular AC 70/7460-1L.
