I acknowledge I am a landholder likely to benefit financially if this project goes ahead.

However quite apart from that personal benefit I am in favour of the project from the environmental point of view as it will contribute to the lessening of global warming. That is my main focus.

I note the project will also provide significant employment in this area in its construction phase & ongoing work for some in its productive time.

I am somewhat concerned about the visual impact of the turbines, as they will be relatively close to our house.

However I haven't found others in our area
problematical visually when driving past them & I have
been very close, say within 100 metres, to a turbine on
Robbess Island, W.A., which supplies all of Robbess
desalination water. There was no visual problem to
me, & very little noise, & a brilliant outcome for
Robbess! I was most impressed. Admittedly, that was
a much shorter tower, but still it was taller than most
skewers near a road on a resort island.

I was similarly very impressed when I learned of
the potential of the Jupiter Wind Farm to supply electricity
to so many homes, helping the planet in the process!

I do trust the project will go ahead.
