

Our house has a wrap around verandah. When we're looking out the window to the east towards the proposed Jupiter area, we can see the current wind monitoring tower which is about 100m. It reaches half way between the horizon and the gutter line of the verandah. This means that the turbines of 173m (or possibly 200m after submission of variations), will fully occupy our view from the horizon to the gutter. Our view will be gone. No amount of mitigation will reverse that.
