I am writing to lodge my strong opposition to the proposed abattoir located at the Blayney Sealink Cold Store Complex, 137 Newbridge Road, Blayney NSW.

From a recent community information meeting I was bewildered to hear that our local council was not opposed to this development given the extensive list of negative issues raised by some very informed people.

My main concern is the incredible amount of B double trucks required to travel right through the centre of town and then turn at an intersection not designed for them. This intersection houses our local post office and a busy school bus stop that my children use twice every day.

It was astounding to hear the actual number of goats being proposed to be slaughtered each and every day and the size and number of trucks required to transport them. I don't profess to know much at all about Q fever, but it is obviously something that I now need to be concerned about.
