Looking at the plans for the feeder road, am able to understand why it has to come past Mananga Homestead circa 1894 and started 1861, using the existing road and SAVING ALL THE TREES THERE, and also not disturbing the historical site near the trees also, as Aboriginal

Culture and history and non Aboriginal (historic heritage) must be preserved there.

I was reassured that the 5 Beautiful Liquid Amber trees and historic site will be preserved and I thank you for this.

The noise of the Bypass coming into Berry will be acceptable to Mananga Homestead and the feeder road also, with minimum disruption to getting to my property, and making a safe cut through the 2 last trees as the exit point onto the road to Berry and back to the Bypass



I appreciate the work involved and would like to congratulate you and your team, and I was informed that this feeder road will not be much wider then it is now, and just the entry and exit points from this feeder road will change as cattle trucks and farm machinery will use this also, and will need a better turning point to enter and exit.

As long as the trees stay and the historic site remains, I am okay with the concept that you are developing within the Berry community.

But on condition that these old Trees stay as does the historic site under the trees Mananga Homestead image below
