The Masonic home east should also be included in this. Most of the residents are now well in they 70's. I am 84 & the eldest man here is 98, with a woman 90. We are all fit and over all are retired, infirmaries. I believe this applies to the Geange. Victoria St is used monthly for markets, also many other activities. The caravan park adjacent always seems to have occupants. The school (BEARY PRIMARY) are well catered for & both are all instructed in road safety. I have seen a bus in Victoria St, which I presume to have high school students travelling to & fro to Nowra & back.

My home care lady lives at Goolangatta. She has other clients here at the Arbour, also Geange, Masonic home, & many private homes.

also each of Arbour, Bushy, Grange & Masonic Homes have staff, more so Bushy. I know three of our staff live south of us.

My bank is at Nowra, I go into Nowra about every two weeks. I have occasional medical appointments in Nowra.

My daughter lives at Culburra Beach usually "collects" us on these occasions & "delivers" me home. I visit her & her family some weekends, staying overnight.

Mark Lagoon Park is another way, everyday people etc come to have a cuppa & use toilet. I know there are plans for an alternative entry East. Why!! is money being spent unnecessary, in my opinion; However a change of Government may alter this, money is a factor also. However by the time it becomes a reality I might be pushing up the daisies. The property access for the resident adjacent is also unnecessary.

I moved to the Arbour from Hemelst just over 5 yrs ago.
