I refer to your email of 27 September 2019 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) – Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR).

The following advice for you to consider is from the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR).

Pre-Approval

A Water Access Licence must be obtained to account for the take of water, including the volume of water taken by dewatering if dewatering activities exceed 3 megalitres per year or occur for a period greater than 12 months.

Post-Approval

The Soil and Water Management Plan should address works within the riparian corridor of Cabramatta Creek and works should be designed in accordance with the Guidelines for Controlled Activities (2012) for Works on Waterfront Land

- In-stream works
- Outlet structures
- Riparian corridors
- Vegetation Management Plan – Rehabilitation of site works
- Watercourse crossings
