On the application SSD 6484, I object to the approval of this applications on the below grounds.

- The original application was rejected in the Land and environment court and the supreme court on merit and a point of law
- There is no changes in the application which ensures the protection of the community from noise, air quality, loss of community
- Mitigation is not measured correctly in any project, that it is effective, there lacks performances parameters
- Economic value of the asset, is far less and decreasing due to market and oversupply of a product.
