## EXHIBITION OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR SYDNEY CITY GRID STAGE 2A (II)

Maritime Services (RMS) for comment. I refer to your letter dated 24 February 2012 (Departments Reference: MP11\_0092) with regard to the abovementioned Environmental Assessment (EA), which was referred to the Roads and

consideration in the determination of the project application: RMS has reviewed the EA and provides the following advisory comments for the Departments

- The layout of the proposed car parking areas, loading docks and access driveway associated with the subject development (including, grades, turn paths, lifts, sight distance requirements, aisle widths and parking bay dimensions) should be in accordance with AS 2890.1- 2004 and AS 2890.2 – 2002 for heavy vehicle usage.
- 2 The width of proposed driveway shall comply with Council's requirements
- ω A Traffic Management Plan shall be submitted to Council for review and approval, for for two way traffic, which allows priority to vehicles entering the car park. vehicles entries/exits the subject site at O'Connell Street under the control of traffic signals
- 4 A Road Occupancy Licence and a Traffic Management Plan shall be submitted to RMS for cause road closure and parking removal review and approval, for special delivery platform used by Ausgrid Substation, which will
- Ö A Demolition and Construction Traffic Management Plan detailing construction vehicle routes, number of trucks, hours of operation, access arrangements and traffic control should be submitted to Council, for approval, prior to the issue of a Construction Certificate.
- 0 All demolition and construction vehicles are to be contained wholly within the site and vehicles must enter the site before stopping.

Roads and Maritime Services

- 7. All vehicles shall enter and exit the site in a forward direction.
- 8. All works associated with the development are to be at no cost to the RMS.
