With 5 of our families living in very close proximity to the site in question we are exceedingly troubled because of the many SERIOUS HEALTH RISKS that will be a threat to Somersby residents and surrounding districts.

Added to this there would be land/ property devaluation. Who would want to buy and live with Silica Dust? Most have worked extremely hard and many still are, to own their home. Having purchased and developed with the obvious belief of increase over time, not decrease, what compensation will there be for devaluation due to the far reaching HEALTH RISKS involved, also the NOISE of 70,000 Ten Ton truckloads per year i.e. approx. 200 trucks per day every day of the year, to dispose of the 700,000 tons of waste processed per annum?
