I feel that I have been ignored, and I'm upset in regards to what the impact of these wind turbines are going to have. I have five small children under 8 years of age and I have concerns regarding the impacted on my family's quality of life.

We purchased this farm to enjoy with our family for our children to appreciate and care for the environment, I believe the wind farm will have a negative impact on the native environment and the domestic stock that will be on my land.

I purchased this land thinking how nice it would be for my family to get away from the city to the peaceful nature environment - but how wrong was I? Now I will soon have to listen to the continuous noise of a wind turbine.

When you purchase real-estate you have a few things in mind.

- 3 Something that will go up in value that they can either enjoy or sell.

I have put in a letter once before stating my concerns for the two originals wind turbines and it fell on deaf ears. Now I hear from my neighbours that another four are to be in stalled and still I haven't been given the common courtesy of a letter informing me of these updates.

I request a reply to this complaint and request a meeting to discuss this matter. I am prepared to take this matter further if required.
