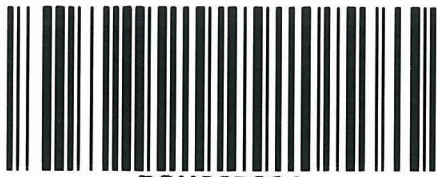

Re. Dye Park Wind Farm (SSD 6693)
Response to Trustpower's "Response to
Submissions" (RTS) actual document.

The proposed changes to the above project do not alleviate any of my concerns, I remain totally opposed.

The actual lack of professional standards displayed in the RTS document does not engender any sense of confidence. Trustpower seemingly promotes the values of community consultation/positive relationships etc. however the format adopted in the written response does not support these values; in its present form, the RTS is anything but user friendly.

* Submissions have not been personally/individually acknowledged, rather jumbled together in the document.

* No index of each submission has been tabulated, such an index could have then listed a specific guide to document location of each specific query

* The three folders, totalling approx 1300 pages / weighing approx 6 kg, (including plastic folders!) makes it difficult and laborious to avoid becoming engulfed in attempts to locate individual answers.

* Maps provided - totally inadequate. Lead to confusion. Details to enable identification of exact location are omitted - eg. creek labels, road signage, property names etc. Appendix D has unnumbered pages, Appendix E shows incorrect labelling of roads, the inset with the "KEY" codes, completely blocks out map details. Table 6-10 gives misspelling of Blakeney Creek (error "Blankey" creek).

It would appear that the maps ^{are} presented in such a manner as a deliberate act to cause confusion.

The failure to have proper standards in that might appear to be trivial matters does not erode Trustpene's ability to cope with more complex issues.

* I visited the Yoro Trustpene's office on 15/6/2016 for assistance in locating specific information. The staff exhibited similar difficulties to my own; with much time & effort some details were retrieved, however they were unable to interpret / identify other queries. This certainly ~~is~~ reinforced that the documents are not "user friendly".

* No documents were made available to the Ry Park community, access only at Beecroft, Yoro, Crookwell. After a request documents were made available at the PO - access is only possible 1 hour on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday. The folders are accessible on June 2, 2016

* I am thankful that the Department of Planning and Environment acknowledges the effort it takes to sort through the RTS. I am most grateful that a slight postponement of date due for extra submissions has been approved.

I do wish to "cross T's" and "dot i's" (quote Mr David Kitto at meeting) as an indication of my genuine fears for the approval of this wind turbine projection, however I may well have to compromise my standards.
