- 1. Minimising the impact of radiant heat and direct flame contact by separating structures from bush fire hazards by identifying adequate asset protection zones in accordance with *Planning for Bush Fire Protection* 2006;
- 2. Providing adequate egress/access to the proposed development as outlined within 4.1.3 of *Planning for Bush Fire Protection* 2006;
- 3. The ability to site and provide for adequate water supplies for bush fire suppression operations;
- 4. Emergency evacuation measures in accordance with section 4.2.7 of *Planning for Bush Fire Protection* 2006; and
- 5. Development of operational procedures related to the mitigation and suppression of bush fire relevant to the proposed development.
