I refer to your email of 1 July 2013 addressed to Ms Slavica Despotovic at the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) regarding the Wollongong Hospital Redevelopment Modification Application (MP10_0213 MOD 1) New Car Park.

CASA has assessed the redevelopment modification application for the new car park and I am advised that, while no operational safety issues have been identified at this stage, the following should be considered:

- Car park lighting and light beams from vehicles are not to create confusion, distraction or glare to pilots in line with regulation 9.94 of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1988.
- Construction crane information should be reviewed at the planning stage and forwarded to CASA for a hazard assessment and to Airservices Australia to assess an impact on the published instrument approach procedures for the development.

I trust this information is of assistance.
