Flyers Creek Wind Farm (MP 08_0252 MOD 3) Comment on the Environmental Assessment (EA)

I refer to your email of 18 May 2017 to the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) in respect to the above matter. Comment has been sought from relevant divisions of DPI. Views were also sought from NSW Department of Industry – Lands and Forestry that are now a division of the broader Department and no longer within NSW DPI. Any further referrals to DPI can be sent by email to landuse.enquiries@dpi.nsw.gov.au.

DPI has reviewed the EA for the proposed modification and provides the following recommendations:

- It is likely that the works proposed in the modification will require new watercourse crossing, but it is not clear in the EA where these crossings will be located. The proponent should detail where watercourse crossings will be required, and ensure that all works undertaken within watercourses, or on waterfront land, are done so in accordance with DPI Water <u>Guidelines for Controlled Activity on Waterfront Land</u> (2012).
- The proponent should consult with Department of Industry Lands and Forestry (<u>lands.ministerials@industry.nsw.gov.au</u>) on possible impacts to Crown land Lot 7002 DP 1019823, and Crown road and Enclosure Permits 20108 and 20112.
