

I refer to your email below. Blayney Shire Council would like to make the following comments;

1. It is noted Council is currently undertaking a significant Capital works program in this vicinity. In the near future, Council will be commencing works in Cadia Road as circled on the attached map. It is noted the works may slightly realign this road in sections to which Infigen Energy have been informed and are aware. This is simply to note only, Council will have undertaken the appropriate REF on any widening.
2. Voluntary Planning Agreement. As noted for Mod 3, a new VPA is required to be negotiated as the previous VPA negotiated on 22 October 2015 now contains properties no longer in the project. Council also notes with this modification the capacity of the Wind Farm has also potential to increase. Council would expect to negotiate a VPA based on the quantum rates identified by the Mining & Energy Related Councils NSW.  
DPE should ensure that any condition in the consent regarding a VPA (condition C16 in mod 3) is worded so that the requirement to negotiate a VPA would not prevent the commencement of the project commencing. Noting the project must be commenced by 14 March 2019.
